EXECUTIVE REPORTS

PRESIDENT Lori McCrea - Teri Lynn Amundson moves "That LMH has the cash raffle of 7500 tickets sold at 10.00 per ticket. Our prizes will be 10 000.00 for first place, 3 000.00 for second place, 2 000.00 for third place, 1 000.00 for fourth place, and 500.00 for fifth place. Our raffle will start October 1, 2019 and continue through to February 15, 2020. Jason Towers second. All in favor. Motion carried. We have been selected to work at the Casino as a fundraiser for LMH and it will take place March 23 & 24, 2020. Once we have the cash raffle going we will start working on this. Lori McCrea moved that "We remove Renee Rudolph, Jacqui Rider and Shelley Vickery from our signing authority on our bank accounts." Tania Dundas second. All in favor motion carried. Lori McCrea moved that "We add our new executive members Erin Fuller, Nicole Antsey and Heather Pedersen to have signing authority on all our bank accounts." Jody Blokland second all in favor motion carried. LMH will not be hosting a table at the Lacombe Active Living Fair this year, however, we will place an ad in Lacombe community Don't Hibernate magazine. Heather Pedersen will look after the ad. Lori McCrea reported that Hockey Alberta is presently putting together a Safety Lead program that will have a rep oversee all aspects of safety in our association. Lori will be attending a meeting September 7 to receive all the information regarding this new position. Corey Shaw and Lori McCrea met with Ponoka Minor Hockey last week regarding Ponoka's bantam players coming to Lacombe to play because they lack numbers. Lori and Corey did not feel that this would be a good fit for our

association. LMH is still interested in putting together a no hit bantam recreational team if we have the interest. The town of Lacombe will not provide sufficient quality ODR ice, however, with LMH only one bantam team this season we should be able to offer practice and game ice time. Red Deer has a no hit bantam rec team this season and if we are unable to come up with sufficient numbers for a team, hopefully, we can send them to Red Deer to play. Bantam director, Joanne Day, will send out an email this week to entice potential players for this team and the cost of registration will be considerably cheaper. The Lacombe Ringette Association has approached Lori about their new U10 ruling for half ice surfaces and they may need to rent our half boards. Hockey Alberta's deadline for player movement was August 1 and two were approved and one was denied. We have some players that are interested in playing for LMH this year if they do not make the CAS team. LMH is thinking about resurrecting our old policy of importing 1 to 3 players if a division needs the numbers increase. LMH wants to make sure our own playe s are looked after first. Jacqui Rider said in the past that this changes on a year to year depending on our numbers. The Eckville Eagles Senior AA team is still thinking of coming to Lacombe and they would like to establish a good working relationship with LMH. Many of these players are from Lacombe. They would really like to change their name to the Rockets or even Merchants.

- 4.2 VICE PRERESIDENT Lori McCrea spoke on behalf of Corey Shaw In seven days all evaluation documents will be ready for division directors. Please make sure that your evaluators are in place and please follow the evaluation process to the letter.
- 4.3 REGISTRAR Jacqui Rider spoke on behalf of Erin Fuller We currently have enough for four teams for atom with five goalies. Peewee will have two teams and four goalies. Bantam one team and no goalies. Midget will have two teams and no goalies. Novice will be three or four teams. Initiation will have two teams.
- 4.4 SECRETARY Heather Pedersen The Don't Hibernate ad for LMH has been approved.
- 4.5 TREASURER Nicole Anstey Payment reminders have been sent to the directors and they must forward them to the parents. If families that are having trouble paying their fees on time continue to communicate and follow the pay schedule arranged for them we will gladly work with them. If communication ceases we will have no choice but suspend their child from hockey.

- 5.6 BANTAM Joanne Day Is still working on recruiting kids for the no hit hockey league and we need to get an idea of numbers. We would like to give them better ice times ie one practice time per week as well as one game time per week. The City of Lacombe is not interested in improving the ODR ice surface for practices. The regular bantam will only have one team and we may need to apply for an oversize team but we may have to look at moving players to other associations.
- 5.7 MIDGET Edith McKinlay 34 registered players with 10 trying out for CAS. According to the numbers we will be in the same situation as last season with a shortage of goalies. Ponoka Minor

Hockey has too many goalies and the goalies from Red Deer that played with us last year would also love to come back and play.
