4. **NEW BUSINESS**

4.1. 2024/25 Registration Fees Overview

Last year, LRA raised fees to help cover the cost of increasing ice rentals, as well as deal with lingering issues from COVID.

For 2024-25, the LRA Board recommended NO changes to registration fees for the upcoming season. This is in part due to last year's fee increases as well as a successful Cash Raffle, which helped to bring our numbers back in line.

NEW FOR 2024-25: LRA will accept e-transfer payments and there will be options to put in your registration number for Kids Sport/Jumpstart into RAMP registration.

Registration will open on April 12, 2024. The AGM discount will be open until May 30, 2024.

4.2. Update to the Screening Policy

- Shelley Leslie would like to motion that we amend Policy 106 Procedure #11 to read:
 - 11. Each person subject to the Policy will obtain and submit a PRC and VSS from their local Police Service using the VSN# assigned to the Club. In addition, each person will submit a letter of good standing from another club, out of province or country to the Club.
- Shelley Leslie would also like to motion that we amend Policy 106 Procedure #12 to read:
 - 12. The PRC, VSS and Letter of good standing will be submitted and uploaded into RAMP by October 15th of that current season OR when assigned a position in the Club.

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4.3. **2024-25 Tournament**

- We will continue to run two smaller, more manageable tournaments in 2024. The tentative dates are:
 - November 22-24
 - January 24-26 (TO BE CONFIRMED)
- This is to help with scheduling, as our tournament has grown so large that we had to split it.
- Lessons learned from last year:
 - Both tournaments will be sanctioned ASAP in September to ensure fewer issues finding teams for the January tournament.
 - Smaller tournaments mean that raffle tables/vendors can be moved downstairs to help with more traffic to the raffle tables.

4.4. Fundraising Expectations

- In order to keep fees down, Lacombe Ringette looks for fundraising opportunities.

 This is an ASSOCIATION fundraiser (team fundraising is separate).
 - Like last year, cash raffle tickets will be sold by every ringette family.
 - If you don't want to sell raffle tickets, chocolates will be offered as an alternative to sell.
- If you have not selected the No Fundraising Option when you register which helps offset the funds that would not be coming in then Lacombe Ringette expects all families to help with fundraising efforts.
- Please note: the No Fundraising Option only applies to association fundraising activities. Families who select that option will still be required to participate in team fundraising activities (if needed).
