

Officiating Options for First Year Officials

First Stripes (Pre-Level)	Level 1
Age: 13 years and up	Age: must be 14 years of age or older by the clinic date
No in-person clinic, online clinic and exam to be completed at your own pace before officiating any games No registration fee	In-person clinic; 3 hours classroom plus 1 hour on the ice; must complete pre-clinic work online before registering Registration fee \$120 (to be reimbursed by home association after you have officiated 4 games)
Levels: U10-1 and U10-2 (half-ice)	Levels: U10-3 and U12C (full-ice)
Required Uniform / Equipment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finger whistle • Black pants • Black helmet • Jersey to be provided by LRA 	Required Uniform / Equipment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finger whistle • Black pants • Black helmet • Official jersey must be purchased
All games to be mentored by senior official Coaches may also be on the ice to assist their teams with rules	Mentored games until you are comfortable without mentor
Teaching aspect while on ice, reminding players of the rules	Role is strictly enforcing the rules

Officials can only be part of one stream – new officials cannot do both half ice and full ice games.

Game fee is the same for all U10 games, half-ice and full-ice.

Junior coaches will NOT be able to officiate the team they are coaching.
