For the Lacombe Ringette Ice Breaker Tournament, people 12 and over* are required to show one of the following every time they enter a facility:

- Proof of full vaccination (two doses) required after October 25.
- Please refer to [Alberta.ca COVID-19 Public Health Actions](#)
- Proof of vaccination must include the person's name, vaccine type and date of administration
- Proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service. (To access a privately-paid PCR or rapid test, please contact your nearest pharmacy or private medical lab. As per the Government of Alberta, tests from AHS or Alberta Precision Laboratories are ineligible for the program.)
- A vaccine medical exemption letter ~includes physician's or nurse practitioner's complete information. Please note: it must also include a statement that there is a medical reason for not being fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Valid personal identification (birth certificate, driver's licence, government issued identification card etc.) is required for adults 18 and over.

**Note: youth under 18 who are participating in a sport, recreation or performance activity will not be required to provide proof of vaccination, proof of privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test or a vaccine medical exemption letter at the participating REP facilities.*

Additional Notes

Arrive Early:

We ask patrons to arrive at facilities a little earlier than normal. Please be patient with volunteers, staff, security as they review vaccination statuses, negative test results and medical exemptions.

Entrances:

Ice Breaker participants are asked to use the main *South doors* for access to the Gary Moe Auto Group Sportsplex.

A host table will also be set up in the main entrances of the Clive and Blackfalds arenas.

Signs will be up to direct Ice Breaker participants.

Masks:

Face coverings/**masks are required indoors.**

Exceptions include: no masking under 2 years old, consuming food or drink, mask medical exception letter.

Masks are not required on the playing surface for those participating in recreation or physical activity.

Team Warm Ups

Team Warm-Ups Warm-up space is available outside, or within your team dressing room.
