- 4.6 ICE ALLOCATOR
  - Final Schedule is ready
  - We have added an extra U10-2 team, so Amanda has had to reconfigure the schedule. We are on an 8 week rotation.
  - U10-1 and U6 are all at the same time on Thurs at 3:45
  - U10-2 and U10-3 will get 10-11 practices in an 8 week rotation, splitting the ice
  - •Older teams stay the same with the exception of the week you are on morning practice
  - ice starts 28/29 of September
  - U6 starts oct 3
  - Back ice starts Sept 28
  - Submitted ice for playdowns in Feb and U10-3 play offs in March with ice in Clive
  - Power skating and goalie clinics will start once we get ice back from Black Gold
  - U10 teams will have some Sunday night practice slots
  - Clive has no ice available
  - U10-2 & U10-3 will rotate through morning ice
  - As an association we need to make sure we don't have any no shows for ice, as we are asking the City of more ice slots. Last year we had 3 no shows (ice after our home tournament)
  - We will have to give up some practice ice for AB winter games
- **4.7** REFEREE ALLOCATOR
  - We are still in need of refs
  - Level 1 clinic in RD on oct 6

- splitting U10 skaters into 2 groups for UAA evaluations was a good idea. A recommendation for next year is to split new skaters evenly between the 2 nights
- UAA sorted most players
- bubble skaters were sorted out at game evaluations
- 5 game evaluators at U10 and U12
- 4 game evaluators at U14
- concerns were sent on to age group directors
- teams are tiered appropriately across the province using the UAA numbers
- Moving forward we would like to make our evaluation process transparent to all: Shelley Leslies has the info from past years. We would like to have this posted to our webpage for next season.

- Suggestion from a new U10 player mom. Her daughter did not enjoy the game evaluation as she did not understand rules.
- Lori Winslow mentioned that in the parent email it was mentioned that parents have the option not to have their child participate in game evaluations
- A suggestion of a welcome package for new ringette families with skills you are looking at in the game evaluations so parents can make a better decision for their child to play or skip the game evaluations, and to prepare their child for what to expect

# U12 & U14 DIVISION DIRECTOR- Karol Warner

- 26 players, 1 player did not come to scrimmage B team
- 12 skaters evaluated UAA as A.
- Took numbers from scrimmages and they mirror the UAA numbers
- UAA, 1 player evaluated as a C skater
- Last years U12 A only had 4 skaters whose UAA numbers placed them in an A division

- Used game evaluations to evaluate games sense and game play
