2024 League Information

1. Scheduling & Tournaments

- a) Practice / Game Days
 - i. Monday/Wednesday All softball and 15U baseball
 - ii. Tuesday/Thursday All baseball except 15U
- b) Crossover Tournament
 - i. U9/9U, U11/11U, and U13/13U: May 25th & 26th.
 - ii. U15/15U, and U18/18U: June 1st & 2nd.
 - iii. Host locations will be posted on the website.
- c) Final Tournament
 - i. U9/9U, U11/11U, U13/13U and U15/15U = June 21, 22, 23rd.
 - ii. U18/18U will be scheduled end of June during the week.
 - iii. Host locations will be posted on the website.

2. 2024 League Rule Edits: Motion 2024-007 Passed - Effective April 15, 2024.

- a) Baseball Gametime Limit for Crossover and Championship play
 - i. No new inning to start after 2 hours and 15 minutes of play unless the game is tied. The start of the game begins when the first pitch is thrown.
- b) Softball Gametime Limit for Crossover and Championship play
 - i. No new inning to start after 1 hour and 30 minutes of play unless the game is tied. The start of the game begins when the first pitch is thrown.
- c) Softball and Baseball There will be NO open innings.
- d) Softball and Baseball Maximum of 5 Run/Half Inning Rule:
 - i. For 11U/13U once the 5th run of the half inning is scored the inning automatically stops no matter how many outs there are, and that half inning is over.
- e) Softball and Baseball Maximum of 7 Run/Half Inning Rule:
 - For 15U/18U once the 7th run of the half inning is scored the inning automatically stops no matter how many outs there are, and that half inning is over. This rule will apply to 15U/18U League Play and Championship play.

3. Team Fees

- a) Entry Fee: U9/9U \$50
- b) Entry Fee: U11/11U & up \$150
- c) Late Entry: \$250 plus team entry fee
- d) Late Withdrawal: \$500 no return on entry fee.

4. Registration & Website:

- a) Rosters associations/teams are responsible for entering team rosters on the LMBL.ca website. Team login info will be provided to associations when they submit their team numbers.
- b) All players must be registered in either Baseball or Softball Alberta, as required.
