#### 6. Business Arising from Minutes

- a) The current state of LMBL is that Elk Point Association has been operating it for several years (since pre-COVID) and requests another Association takes over the league governance.
- MOTION: Dennell A. motioned that St. Paul Minor Ball to take over the Lakeland Minor Ball League governance from Elk Point.
  - Seconded By Real Bourbeau. Carried.
- St. Paul Minor Ball Association accepts the nomination subject to proposed path forward as presented during the meeting.

#### 7. New Business:

- a) Proposed Path Forward
  - i. Governance model (Please refer to attached pdf document)
    - Dedicated LMBL board governance with 4 executive seats plus district and Zone 7 association directors. Max 13 seats.
      - a. Add social media Director (website & Facebook)
      - b. Add Chief Umpire Director
  - Rules
    - 11U/U11 up: Continue to align with Baseball and Softball Alberta rules.
    - 9U / U9 Modified: Continue with Lakeland modified rules.

- Umpire recruitment and retention remain a large issue for the league.
- 4. Assignment of umpires remain at the local Association level.
- Suggestion to recruit outside of the 'ball world' and find others through the school system.
- iii. Tournaments
  - Overall feedback was positive for the May and June tournaments both Baseball and Softball. Will continue this path into the 2024 season.
  - Will review separate weekends for Baseball & Softball and not overall with Provincial qualifiers to assist with umpires / player scheduling.
- iv. Handover from Elk Point
  - Each Minor Ball Association will continue to share and promote technical training sessions on Facebook.
  - Look at creating a LMBL Facebook page to support information sharing.
  - 3. Margaret Bayduza offered to keep supporting the LMBL website.
