- d. **SQS:**

 - iii. Hopefully we'll start seeing some thing within the next 2 months.
- e. **Coach Training:**
 - i. This will be the most difficult part of SQS to achieve as there's a shortage of training across the province
 - ii. Will try to put courses on during the off season
 - iii. Had some questions about putting on a C License course:
 - Working on hosting requirements. LLB had hosted 3 years ago that was well attended
 - iv. Question from Vegreville: Making Ethical Decisions, is it a requirement?
 - Josh: yes, it is
 - ED: during September the MED is ½ price, it fills up quickly because it's for multiple sports
 - Veg: can they take it if they haven't taken any other courses?
 - Josh: yes, they can. You can take it online or in-person, or challenge the course
