I have been coaching soccer since 2014, and coaching for Lakewood since 2016. I started coaching soccer to try to make my own kids more comfortable as they started a new sport. I ended up enjoying it so much that I haven't stopped!

My coaching credentials include Fundamentals

and Learn to Train. I am currently coaching the Lakewood U9BD Sounders and U13GB1 Chelsea teams.

As a youth I played soccer for the Mount Royal community association from Grades 3-7. Although I didn't play for long or at a high level, I've always thought of soccer as by far the best sport for kids, especially for its low cost and high engagement.

I have four children, all of whom either have played or are currently playing for Lakewood. I am a teacher in the unique role as a hospital school teacher at JPCH.

I enjoy coaching at the development level (U7-U13). I believe there is a great soccer athlete inside every young person, and that our role as coaches is to keep of our players engaged and interested until that potential emerges. That might happen at age 6 for some, age 16 for others!

My greatest source of pride is seeing the players that I coach come back year after year. Although I'm not coaching the current U15GA, it gives me great joy to know that I have worked with over half of them at a younger age.

Each player that is registered with Lakewood submitted a Volunteer Bond. If you would like to review the Volunteer Requirements please see our website. A minimum number of hours must be completed in order to get your \$100 Volunteer Bond returned. Even if your team is not playing in the tournament, it is still the best time to fulfill your Volunteer Requirements for the season. If you are planning on volunteering during the tournament, ONE SHIFT per player will cover your Volunteer Requirements.

The online SignUp will be LOCKED at noon on Tuesday January 30th to allow us to find people to fill remaining shifts. This means you will no longer have access to choose your volunteer shift. Please sign up before this deadline!

All shifts that have not been claimed by noon on Tuesday will be offered as paid shifts at \$50/shift. If you have outstanding fees owing, any paid shifts will be put towards your balance.

If you are coaching/assistant coaching/ managing a team you MUST be registered in RAMP and have met the minimum requirements. Your volunteer hours are considered done if you are helping out with a



team in this way. Please reach out if you are coaching/assistant coaching/managing and are not yet registered. You can contact info@lakewoodsoccer.com


If you are unsure whether you are exempt from volunteering please reach out asap.


Revolution Fundraiser
