# Lakewood in your school!

Lakewood has just started a new program where we are delivering soccer training as part of the physical education classes at several elementary schools in the Lakewood area. This started April 24 and will continue until the end of the school year. This program is being coordinated by our **Developmental Soccer Coordinator, Erica** Hindmarsh. Erica is working with the elementary school administrators to schedule the days when we will be at each school. We are trying to schedule 5 days at each school. We have two Developmental Soccer Specialists, Keisuke Johnston and Leah Rioux who will be delivering the in-school soccer programming. The programming will take place during the regular physical education classes at these schools.

There are 14 elementary schools in the Lakewood area of Saskatoon, and we plan to deliver programming to 7-9 of these schools during the April 24 to June 27



period. We will resume this program in September, and we will visit the remaining Lakewood area schools during the next school year.

Current schools this spring are: St Luke, Colette Bourgonje, St. Bernard, Bishop Pocock, Wildwood, and Lakeview.
