SSCI FACILITY PROTOCOLS & IMPROVEMENTS

* Dates & recommendations are subject to change based on guidance from government officials & health professionals

SANITATION

- Additional hand sanitizing stations installed.
- Segregated entries & exits.
- Stringent cleaning & sanitation protocols established & followed.

SAFETY

- SSCI is available for indoor & outdoor fields & beach court rentals only. No equipment (goals only), benches, dressing rooms/showers, or common areas will be provided for use. Facility access will be limited based on government guidelines.
- Individuals with high-risk health conditions should avoid coming to SSCI facilities.
- SSCI strongly recommends that all individuals wear face coverings when possible & practice good hygiene.
- Water fountains limited to bottle filling only.
- SSCI members & guests must follow the CDC social distancing guidelines in order to be onsite in his/her designated area of capacity. Please avoid close contact with those around you.
- Guest access may be limited based on provincial & facility-recommended parameters.
- As always, absolutely no spitting or mucus secretions will be permitted. Violators will be immediately removed.
- Players & teams will be required to ensure no athlete shares cups, bottles, or other items.
- No changing on the field is allowed. All players are to come fully dressed & leave the field immediately following rental.

STRUCTURE

- No team or official benches on fields.
- No dressing rooms or showers will be available for use.
- Minimal spectator attendance requested, physical distancing must be maintained, limited spectator seating available.

SIGNAGE

- Social distancing guidelines will be displayed throughout the facilities.
- Sidewalk graphics will be located in high traffic areas to indicate directional flow & 2 meter (6 foot) distancing.
- Restroom signage will be displayed to promote safe practices, good hygiene & health guidelines.

SERVICES

- Increased communications with members, guests, & the public.
- List of resources & recommendations available for all members & guests.

STAFF

- Staff will be screened for symptoms & illness prior to every shift.
- Staff will carry hand sanitizer & cleaning wipes at all times.
- Stringent cleaning and sanitation protocols will be established & followed.
