FACILITY USE GUIDELINES FOR GAMES



This document is subject to change at any time with new direction provided by the Saskatchewan Health Authority, Government of Saskatchewan, Town of Langenburg, Saskatchewan Hockey Association, Hockey Canada and the Major Hockey League.

The Langenburg Minor Hockey Association would like to welcome teams, spectators and officials from our surrounding communities for the 2020-2021 minor hockey season. As a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, several requirements have been set by multiple governing bodies in order to return to playing hockey, and to use our local facility.

Please ensure anyone attending the Langenburg Remax Arena has reviewed this document and is able to comply with all the requirements.

- Do not enter the Arena if experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Players, coaches and team officials can enter the Arena 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of a game, no sooner. Players, coaches and team officials must exit the Arena within 30 minutes of the end of a game.

*** 1 parent of a U7 or U9 player may enter the Arena with their child to assist with getting dressed but must remain in the dressing room until the scheduled start of the game.

- Spectators can enter the Arena at the scheduled start time of a game, no sooner. Spectators must exit the Arena within 15 minutes of the end of a game.
- Any person entering the Arena must sign in at the admission gate by providing name and contact information.
- Any person leaving the Arena during the course of a game must sign out at the admission gate.
- Any person entering the Arena must use the designated entrance, any person leaving the Arena must use the designated exit.
- Announcements will be made to direct spectator exiting.
- Home team spectators will sit in Sections 3 and 4*. Away spectators will sit in Section 1*. Section 2* has been reserved for overflow seating.
- Sections 3 and 4* will exit through the main lobby doors. Sections 1 and 2* will exit through the main entrance doors.

- Once in the Arena spectators must proceed directly to the seating area.
- There will be no indoor seating available and limited heated seating. Spectators should be dressed for cold temperatures.
- A maximum of 150 people will be allowed in the Arena at any given time (excluding players, coaches and officials).
- Spectators must not enter any area of the Arena that has been roped/cordoned off by Arena staff.
- Spectators may sit with people of their extended household, however they must be 2 metres away from any other person/extended household.
- Physical distancing of 2 metres must be adhered to (outside of extended households) at all times within the Arena.
- Dressing rooms are available for use, larger teams will be assigned 2 dressing rooms each.
- Physical distancing must be adhered to within dressing rooms. 10 players are able to use each dressing room.
- Common areas such as lobbies, hallways and washrooms will be frequently sanitized by Arena staff.
- There will not be a concession/kitchen available.
- Spectators are to remain in their seat for the duration of the game. Visiting, moving around and congregating is strongly discouraged.
- Anyone attending the Arena must wear a face covering while inside at all times. Players and officials may remove their face covering when putting on their helmet immediately prior to going on the ice surface.
 - *** The only exceptions for face coverings are:
 - Children under the age of 2.
 - Anyone who has a diagnosed respiratory, neurologic or mental health condition that precludes the safe use of face coverings.
 - Anyone who is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the face covering without assistance.

Should any attendee fail to comply with any of the requirements, games will not begin or resume until the attendee has complied. Should the attendee continue to refuse to comply with any of the requirements facility officials may be required to contact the Esterhazy/Langenburg RCMP.
