



2021 Leduc Baseball Association **Registration & Season Information**

Registration for the **2021 Season opens shortly**. Stay tuned to this page, our twitter, and facebook pages for registration information!

Due to the uncertainty of what the season will entail this year's **registration will not have any initial fees** associated with it. All fees will be determined once we have a better handle on the length and scope of the season. We encourage everyone to register as soon as possible as there will be registration caps at most levels.

LBA is determined that we will have a 2021 season. We are preparing for a number of different scenarios and we will continue to work together with the City of Leduc and Baseball Alberta to determine exactly what the season will look like.

At this point there are 3 possible scenarios for the 2021 Season (as per Baseball Alberta):

SCENARIO #1

- Similar to 2020 season
- Cohort application would be in place
- Cohort limit of 50 (subject to change)
- Cohort limit does not include coaches / officials / staff (further AHS requirements apply to these individuals)

SCENARIO #2

- Cohort limit of 50 (subject to change)
- Teams will be placed in cohorts for set number of play weekends
- Following each SET of play weekends , teams will have a 2 week break where they will be limited to activities strictly within their team
 - Newly formed cohorts will continue following the 2 week break

SCENARIO #3

- Similar to 2019 season
- Schedules would be created with teams having the ability to play each other without cohort restrictions
- Potential to attend Post- Provincial Championships (dependant on Baseball Canada)
