All players are required to supply their own batting helmet, ball glove, jock or jill and athletic footwear. U11 to U18 players need to supply their own white ball pants and black belt.

Competitive "AA" Teams:

It is our intent to field 1 AA teams in each division –11U thru to 18U. Player evaluations will be held at all levels for those players interesting in trying out. AA tryout schedule will be posted online and communicated to all those who register for tryouts. Majority of games are played on weekends at locations throughout the province. League play begins May 1st and finishes the 1st weekend in August. A Level up fee of \$200 is required for all AA players and AA teams fundraise to cover all additional expenses for team gear and additional tournaments.

Competitive "A" Teams:

New for 2019 LBA will be putting together "A" division teams that will compete in house league during the regular season and after the completion in June, they will continue to play in the Alberta "A" Division League into July with the final weekend being "A" Alberta Provincials on the 3rd weekend in July. There will be level up fees of \$50 for players that play on these teams.

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Fundraising:

As we are a not for profit organization fundraising is our primary source of revenue for our program and we appreciate your commitment and support.

Please note that each family is required to select 2 fundraising/volunteer options itemize below:

1. Work TWO (2) BINGO fundraising events for the season.
2. Work ONE Bingo and one of options below.
3. Sell 5 raffle ticket booklets of 20 tickets in each booklet, you will responsible to sell all of the tickets or pay the difference of those not sold.
4. Monetary: pay \$250 to cover off 1of 2 family fundraising requirements.
5. Monetary: pay \$500 to cover both of your families fundraising/volunteer commitments.
 - a. Please note: that each family is required to fulfill their volunteer commitments and if they don't then we will charge their account \$250 for each volunteer commitment not met, or
6. Become a member on the LBA Executive team which counts as both volunteer commitments. Attend the Annual General Meeting on February 15t11 to be nominated for a position on the Board.
7. Head Coaching positions also count for both volunteer commitments but you must first select your 2 volunteer fundraising options and submit a coaching application. Once selected by the Coaching committee we will remove your volunteer option previously selected.

You are responsible for your bingo shifts. We will call to remind you of these shifts. If we leave a message please respond to the message and return the call to confirm you have received the message. This helps us in planning for no shows. If you are not able to work, you will be responsible for finding a suitable substitute to cover the shift.

Cancellation Policy: If you absolutely cannot fulfill a volunteer commitment that you committed to, the volunteer Coordinator must be given notice at least 2 weeks prior to the event so someone else can be secured to fill the spot. An unexcused no-show as deemed by the LBA executive will result in a \$250 charge against that individuals credit card within 30 days of the no show. This charge will only be returned to that individual once they have completed their volunteer requirement or a substitute for that volunteer requirement.

Uniform Deposit:

The uniform deposit will be charged to your credit card if your child's jersey is not returned to the head coach at the end of the season.
