## Welcome to the 2021/22 NAHL U13AA Regional Tournaments

## Edmonton (Capital Division), Spruce Grove (Regional Division),

## Camrose (White Division) and Lakeland (Black Division)

## TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. All games in the round robin will remain as TIED games (NO overtime).
2. All Capital Division round robin games will be one hour and thirty minute $(20,20,15)$
3. The Regional, White and Black Divisions round robin and playoff games will be three (3) stop time twenty (20) minute periods.
4. Tournament points awarded as follows: wins 2 points, ties 1 point and loses 0 points.
5. In Round Robin play the home team is the team that finished higher in the standings at the end of the regular season and is indicated by being on the right-hand side of the schedule.
6. All Capital Division teams will supply Game Sheets and Incident Reports. Make sure there are at least 2 incident reports with every game sheet.
7. All Capital Division teams will supply their own warm up and game pucks.
8. Capital, Regional, White and Black Divisions RT Host will supply Scorekeeper/Timekeeper.
9. Capital Division Scorekeeper/Timekeeper will pay the Referee and the two lineman.
10. Each team "Must" supply one (1) person to man the penalty box doors.
11. Host Regional Tournament Team will supply Game Sheets and Incidents Reports. Make sure there are at least 2 incident reports with every game sheet.
12. Host Regional Tournament Team will also supply warm up and game pucks.
13. Capital Division Home Team Managers and the Host Regional Tournament Team will send a scanned copy of the game sheet and any incident reports to Warren Williams immediately following game completion. Any suspensions will be sent to the offending teams manager/head coach.
14. PLAY-OFFS: Semi-Final and Finals. Hockey Canada Official Overtime, Rule \#10.16 Tied Game. 10minute OT (do not change ends, same as $1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ periods), if still tied ice is cleaned teams change ends (same as $2^{\text {nd }}$ period) and 20 min periods until goal is scored.
15. PLAY-OFFS: Semi-Finals and Finals. Home Team is determined by the team that is the higher seeded team in the round robin.

The procedure for determining final standings in the event teams are tied during the League Regional Tournament after round robin play.

1- If teams are tied, the teams will be ranked with the team with the most wins will finish higher.
2- If teams are still tied, the team with the best win/loss/tie record in games played against each other will finish higher. Only applies if teams have played against each other in round robin play.
3- If still tied after 1 and 2 then the team with the best goal differential in total tournament play will finish higher. (Ex. team has 25 goals for and 12 goals against, their differential would be +13)
4- If still tied after 1, 2, and 3 then fewest goals against, then most goals for, then fewest penalty minutes, all in games total tournament play.
5- Final tiebreaker is a coin toss.
