

LRA - Return to Ringette Expectations:

Please note this is a fluid situation, and things can change at any time.

- **DAILY HEALTH AND WELLNESS SCREENING** must be filled out and handed in at each skate. You will be required to print, sign and bring the Daily Health Form to each pre-season skate/skill development. You will not be permitted to skate without the screening.
- **ACCESS** - Players will be permitted into the LRC 15 minutes before their scheduled time only. Players are to come fully dressed, in full ringette equipment, if possible: exception: skates and helmet, which can be put once in the arena.
- **Leduc Ringette is not allowing access to the Change rooms for changing at this time.** Teams have not been established, so players must come dressed and leave dressed. Players will be able to drop their bags and put on their skates and helmets in the assigned change rooms only at this time.
 - If your child is not able to tie their own skates, we recommend that they come into the LRC with skates on and wearing skate guards. There is very limited access to tying areas down by the rink.
 - **ROLLER SKATE GUARDS** are not permitted in the LRC hallways. It is recommended that you purchase a pair of skate guards that can be walked in.
 - **NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CHANGE ROOMS** this season. Parents are not considered part of the team cohorts for U10-U19 levels. Non-compliance with this could jeopardize the LRA insurance and the ability to operate this year.
- **WATER BOTTLES** - each participant must have their own water bottle clearly marked.
- **EQUIPMENT ADJUSTMENTS** - Instructors/Coaches cannot help tie skates, fix helmets, etc. Please ensure your child's equipment fits and is comfortable.
- **BATHROOM** - Please go to the bathroom before arriving. Limited access to washrooms is expected.
- **LRA is requiring all players to wear a mask coming into the rinks and changerooms.** They will be able to remove their masks when putting on their helmets to go onto the ice and will be required to replace their masks when helmets are removed to leave. This is a required policy in most municipalities in which we will be playing. Masks are not required on the ice for players.

- **INSTRUCTORS** – will do their best to keep at least one stick length distance from players, although there are times this will not be possible.
- **SPECTATORS (ONLY ONE PARENT/GUARDIAN IS PERMITTED)** – The LRC has recently updated its policy to allow spectators within the max number of 50 participants within each arena (This includes players, instructors and parents). To ensure we comply with regulations, only one spectator per family will be permitted; no additional children will be allowed. Please arrange childcare for other children. **SPECTATORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR MASKS** and are not allowed to yell or cheer in the LRC.
- **The LEDUC REC CENTRE** has recently updated its access and maps. It is vital that we cooperate with the LRC (and every other arena we will visit).
 - **Ensure you are following all posted entrance and exit requirements. An updated map has been attached.**
 - **Players are to be dropped off at the rink and parents are to proceed to the approved viewing areas. There is no loitering throughout the main hallways by the rinks.**
