3. Approval October 2025 minutes: Nicole approves amendment, Shawna seconds.

 - Potential per-team deficit up to \$14,000 if unchanged
 - Consider raising rates, mandatory fundraising, policy alignment with Beaumont
 - Discussion re: Need clearer budget/forecast and real-time tracking
 - Kennedy confirmed endorsement for an accounting software. Shawna confirmed she will research softwares, and costs and bring back to board.
 - Issue with Elavon is resolved.

 - Delivery date updated. 10-14 days.
- f) Ice Allocator's Report – Alicia Kardelis
 - Commit for provincials is for Open. All other divisions need to opt-out if they don't want to participate.
- g) Referee-In-Chief's Report – Kaitlyn Paul
 - Provided budget for clinic reimbursement.
 - Shawna: are we reimbursing everyone, for everything?
 - Kennedy: having refs in leduc reduces travel costs. We need the local refs to level up and do higher level games. We have a number of referees doing training.

 - Repooling meeting on November 25, 2025. Update will be provided following the meeting.

- j) Fundraising & Bingo Report – Kristen Davis
 - WTT will offer 378-400 hours.
 - Amanda motioned to cover box duties for Open C, Laretta seconds.
 - Ideas for additional fundraisers at tournament: almond sales.
 - Need to consider alternative options to raise funds.
 - Will offer incentive to teams attending WTT to drive 50/50 sales. Team that sells the most, and meets a min. Will win a giftcard. (Giftcard being sourced from local restaurants - goal is for a donation).
- k) Coach Coordinator – Jovan Painchaud
 - Just catching up on ensuring coaches have their qualifications.
- l) Manager Coordinator – Nicole Liddle
 - Nothing additional from agenda.
- m) Evaluations Coordinator - Kevin Paul
 - Next season, AA transitions to a Northern Alberta AA league (no longer under BGL); league will have its own rules/bylaws.
 - Target is three AA teams per age group (U14, U16, U19).
 - Plan to move to full centralization by 2027–28 (Calgary model: select top ~60 players, split into three teams; remaining players return to home associations for A/B/C).
 - U14 next season: tryouts organized by quadrants due to numbers; Spruce Grove and St. Albert expected to anchor two U14 teams.
 - Leduc/Beaumont U14 players pursue AA via the Edmonton grouping (e.g., Sherwood Park, Fort Sask, Beaumont, Leduc).
 - U16/U19: still three teams each, but zones differ from U14 based on player distribution; Leduc at these ages likely grouped with Beaumont + Edmonton.
 - Northern Alberta AA league will play interlocks vs Calgary AA teams.

 - Seeking upcoming items to promote; please share events and news proactively.
 - Wants more content contributions from board members (not only teams) to strengthen community presence.
 - Emphasis on low-budget, high-visibility community engagement (showing presence, highlighting refs, behind-the-scenes).
