

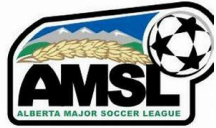

LETHBRIDGE FC U10 – U12 Tier 1, 2 and 3 – Program Overview

All players, parents and coaches should be aware of the nature of this program before starting the season. The focus is constantly on technical development of players not the results or scorelines:

Program kicks off in October 2024;

There will be 2 on-field sessions a week; Tuesday and/ or Thursday and Sunday's

Most gamedays for LFC U10 – U12 teams will be during tournaments and any exhibition games;

4 sessions with **The Bridge** to work on biomechanics and soccer movement;



Coach Evaluation/Feedback (on going)

LETHBRIDGE FC – Tier 1 and Tier 2 -U13 (2012), U15 (2010-2011) & U17 (2008-2009)



The LFC Competitive Program provides year-round training and games for committed players from the ages of under 13 to under 17, who aspire to play competitive soccer.

LFC— Brief Technical Overview



Teams play to a tailored curriculum that will provide players with a fun, energetic and competitive environment focused on individual player development. Within this program the aim is to enhance the technical skills learned in the LFC Development program and to build a tactical understanding of the game needed. We also begin to introduce techniques and awareness for strength & conditioning and injury prevention.

While we fully understand how 'winning' can positively affect player development, it is a by-product of a solid technical-tactical base and of a club's player development philosophy.

Depending on circumstances, age groups will be made up of tiered teams. Players are subject to movement throughout the year to allow maximum opportunity and based on ability, attitude, commitment to the game and what LFC staff believe is best for the player's current stage of development. Our emphasis is player-centric with development as the number one priority. We focus on the CSA '4 corner model' to improve the technical, tactical, physical and psychological development of all individuals. For LFC includes on-field sessions, exhibitions, tournaments, using professional sports training services and video analysis led by qualified coaches. (U13 – U17 Age groups)



LFC – Program Overview

All players and parents should be aware that the LFC program requires a certain amount of time and commitment throughout the entire season. The focus is on developing players ready to compete within a competitive soccer environment.

Program kicks off in October 2024;

2 Approved Tournaments:

U13 – U17 – 2 out of town + Provincials (March 2025) + local home tournament (Nov. 29- Dec.1, 2024) if enough registrations for particular age groups



LFC Coaching – Certification Requirements



While many of our LFC teams are led by volunteer coaches, Canada Soccer and Alberta Soccer have strict guidelines to the minimum requirements soccer volunteers and coaches must hold to work with players.

Coaching Qualifications - Minimum certifications required:

- Fundamentals or Learn to Train Certification
- Respect in Sport
- Making Ethical Decisions
- Making Headway
- Valid Criminal Record Check

All LFC Coaches will be encouraged to gain Canada Soccer Association (CSA) Licensing. These courses are vital phase in coach development and improving the knowledge, understanding and delivery of coaches working in competitive youth soccer.

We are proud of all our U13 + Coaches for their hard work in achieving their C- License Certifications.

LFC Evaluations



LETHBRIDGE FC is selection -based programs.

All players looking to play in these programs must attend a 'LFC Evaluations' within their own age-group to have their current soccer abilities evaluated by LFC staff. Following those evaluations, the LFC Staff will either place the player within an LFC team or advise the player they would be better suited by LYS League Program at their current stage of development.
