There will be no registrations accepted after December 31st with the exception of players moving into Lloydminster.

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PLAYER REGISTRATION POLICY

-Players **MUST** reside within LMHA boundaries. Any players residing outside LMHA boundaries are subject to LMHA approval and appropriate provincial approval.

-Players must register in their own age level category. LMHA guideline for player movement to a higher age level category will only be considered if the player is evaluated in the top 10% of the higher category. For requests to be evaluated in the higher division, a non-refundable evaluation fee of \$300 will be charged for each request. If the player makes a higher division, applicable division fees must be paid. All player movement is subject to approval by LMHA Executive and Division Director.

REQUIRED FORMS (Can be found online at www.lloydminsterminorhockey.com)

1. Parent Declaration Form – For players who have moved into LMHA boundaries. Hockey Alberta requires that this form must be accompanied by two additional pieces of documentation to verify the address information. This documentation can consist of:
 - a. A proof of sale document for a house or home with the family's name and address.
 - b. A letter from a school indicating that the player is registered with the school.
 - c. A utility bill, with the family's name and address.
 - d. Any piece of Government issued document that contains the family's name and address (eg. Driver's License, Tax Assessment, etc.)
2. Permission to Try out Form – Any player who resides outside LMHA boundaries is considered a non-resident player or import and must complete this required form before participating in any try-outs.
3. Notification of Try-Out Form (for Elite Hockey only) – All players trying out for Elite Hockey who reside outside of LMHA boundaries must submit this form before try-outs.
4. Player Verification Form – To be completed by players who reside outside LMHA boundaries. (Alberta residents only)
5. SK Hockey Association Concession – LMHA boundaries on the Saskatchewan side are the city limits. LMHA has an agreement with SK Hockey to allow any players that reside in rural Saskatchewan, but fall within the Lloydminster Public School Division K to 9 boundaries, to be included in a blanket concession that LMHA will obtain on the player's behalf(regular season only). All other non-resident SK side players must apply for their own concession from the Saskatchewan Hockey Association. ***Any required releases, concessions, or other documentation must be submitted to LMHA before the player's first ice-time, and is the responsibility of the player. LMHA will try to ensure that players are aware of all required documentation at the time of registration. However, it is ultimately the parent's responsibility to read registration policies and complete any required documents. PARTIAL YEAR FEES- (Dates based on player's first ice time)

Registration after November 31st – 80% of annual fee plus \$20.00

Registration after December 31st – 60% of annual fee plus \$20.00

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REFUND POLICY

Following amounts will be refunded as per dates below;

100% of annual fee less \$20.00 – Until September 1st, 2021

80% of annual fee less \$20.00 – First Skate – October 31st 2021

60% of annual fee less \$20.00 November 1st – November 30th 2021

40% of annual fee less \$20.00 December 1st – December 31st 2021

TEAM FEES

Set at team level to cover socks, apparel, tournaments, etc...

POND HOCKEY

Pond Hockey (formerly Grassroots) is a recreational program for all levels from U7-U18. Players are grouped by division, with no set teams. Non-contact hockey games and will be played twice per week in town only, with no practices.

ELITE HOCKEY PROGRAM

U-18 AAA, Minor AAA (U16), U-15 AAA, U-18 AAA Female, and U-15/U-18 AA Female

Players residing outside of LMHA boundaries who wish to try-out with an Elite Team must first complete a Notification to Try-Out Form and submit to their resident minor hockey association and the team to which the player wishes to try-out for. A player must first tryout for the team in the Elite Draw Zone Area where the player resides. If the player does not make the team they are trying out for, they may have the option to try-out for the next closest Elite Team as defined by the Elite Draw Zone Areas. Local players wanting to try-out for an Elite Team will register with LMHA in the appropriate division. Should the player NOT make the Elite team, player will be charged the Evaluation fee for the next level.

U-11 NAI, U-13, U-15, U-18 AA Programs;

Notification to Try-out for players residing in draw zone not currently registered to LMHA must be filled out.
