DEADLINE TO REGISTER IS June 30th, 2022

After this date, there is a \$150.00 late fee.

Players will be accepted based on availability within the appropriate division.

There will be no registrations accepted after December 31st except for players moving into Lloydminster.

- **NEW PLAYERS** email ice@lloydminsterminorhockey.com for a New Player Registration Package and bring it back to the office to register.
- **To register online you must currently be a returning 2021/2022 season member.** Please follow the link above to complete registration.
- **You must have a land location address if you have a PO Box.**
- For returning players registering and paying online you may choose (1) full payment, (2) payment, or (3) payment option.
- Player is fully registered when all base fees are paid in full, completed registration information received, Respect in Sport Parent is passed.
- Both Elite tryouts and AA selection registration forms will be released in mid-August. Fees for each skate to be paid at first skate.
- 50/50 tickets will be paid for at the time of being placed on a team. These tickets are part of the registration fees. ****FUNDRAISER OF \$200.00 PER FAMILY****
- **Don't have a credit card?** - You can print off your player's registration form and mail it into the office with a check or you can come down and see us in person. We accept debit payment at the office as well.

***NSF checks and failed credit card payment immediately VOID the player's registration and the registration process will need to be completed again with a \$45.00 NSF fee and late registration charges being applied if applicable. Players may be placed on a waiting list if the division is full.**

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PLAYER REGISTRATION POLICY

-Players **MUST** reside within LMHA boundaries. Any players residing outside LMHA boundaries are subject to their association and provincial approval.

-Players must register in their own age level category. LMHA guidelines for player movement to a higher age level category will only be considered if the player is evaluated in the top 10% of the higher category. For requests to be evaluated in the higher division, a non-refundable evaluation fee of \$300 will be charged for each request. If the player makes a higher division, applicable division fees must be paid. All player movement is subject to approval by the LMHA Executive and Division Director.

REQUIRED FORMS (Can be found online at www.lloydminsterminorhockey.com under the Registration tab)

1. Parent Declaration Form – For players who have moved into LMHA boundaries. Hockey Alberta requires that this form must be accompanied by **two** additional pieces of documentation to verify the address information. This documentation can consist of:
 - a. A proof of sale document for a house or home with the family's name and address.
 - b. A letter from a school indicating that the player is registered with the school.
 - c. A utility bill, with the family's name and address.
 - d. Any piece of Government issued document that contains the family's name and address (e.g. Driver's License, Tax Assessment, etc.)
2. Player Birth Certificate
3. Notice to Try out Form – Any player who resides outside LMHA boundaries is considered a non-resident player or import and must complete this required [form](#) before participating in any try-outs within the **female elite tryouts**. Male elite tryouts no longer require an NTO, but to register with your Draw zone Association.
4. Player Verification Form – To be completed by players who reside outside LMHA boundaries. (Alberta residents only)
5. SK Hockey Association Concession – LMHA boundaries on the Saskatchewan side are the city limits. LMHA has an agreement with SK Hockey to allow any players that reside in rural Saskatchewan but fall within the Lloydminster Public School Division K to 9 boundaries, to be included in a blanket concession that LMHA will obtain on the player's behalf (regular season only). All other non-resident SK side players must apply for their own concession from the Saskatchewan Hockey Association. ***Any required releases, concessions, or other documentation must be submitted to LMHA before the player's first ice-time and is the responsibility of the player. LMHA will try to ensure that players are aware of all required documentation at the time of registration. However, it is ultimately the parent's responsibility to read registration policies and complete any required documents. RESPECT IN SPORT PARENT

Please see the link below for access to your account or to make a new account. All families must have at least one parent that carries a valid Respect in Sport Certificate. All children must be added to the account as they start hockey. Players will not be allowed to skate until they are added to a Respect in Sport account. 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REFUND POLICY

Following amounts will be refunded as per dates below;

100% of annual fee less \$20.00 – Until September 1st, 2022

80% of annual fee less \$20.00 – First Skate – October 31st, 2022,

60% of annual fee less \$20.00 November 1st – November 30th 2022

40% of annual fee less \$20.00 December 1st – December 31st 2022

NO REFUNDS WILL BE PROCESSED AFTER JANUARY 1ST OF THE CURRENT HOCKEY SEASON

*Refunds will be based on the date the written request is received by the LMHA Office Administrator.

PARTIAL YEAR FEES- (Dates based on player's first ice time)

Registration after December 31st – 60% of annual fee plus \$20.00

TEAM FEES

Set at team level to cover socks, apparel, tournaments, etc...

POND HOCKEY

Pond Hockey (formerly Grassroots) is a recreational program for all levels from U7-U18. Players are grouped by division, with no set teams. Non-contact hockey games and practices will be played twice per week in town only.

ELITE HOCKEY PROGRAM

U18AAA/AA, U17AAA, U16AA, U15AAA/AA, U13AA, U11AA, Female U18AAA/AA, U15AA

Players residing outside of LMHA boundaries who wish to try-out with an **Elite Male Team** will no longer be required to submit a NTO to try out for AA or AAA, instead, they will only need to register with their Elite Draw Zone association/AA Recruitment Area association, from there, the onus will fall to AAA/AA association to communicate a full list of players trying out to resident MHAs with players attending tryouts. A player must first tryout for the team in the Elite Draw Zone Area where the player resides. If the player does not make the team they are trying out for, they may have the option to try-out for the next closest Elite Team as defined by the Elite Draw Zone Areas. Local players wanting to try-out for an Elite Team will register with LMHA in the appropriate division. Should the player NOT make the Elite team, the player will be charged the Evaluation fee for the next level. All Females teams are still requiring a Notice to Try Out Form before they can tryout.
