



2024-2025 Registration Information

We will be using the TeamSnap registration platform once again.

- All fees to be paid online.
- You can choose to pay in four (4) equal installment payments. (1st payment due upon registration, 2nd payment on June 15th, 3rd payment on July 15th, 4th payment on August 15th) Anyone registering after August 15th must make payment in full.
- Make sure you register by June 30th, 2024, to avoid a late fee. Registrations starting July 1st will increase by \$200.00. This additional amount is non-refundable.
- Payment needs to be paid in full before the season starts.
- Contact the LMHA office if you have any questions. office@lloydminsterminorhockey.com
- The LMHA Office will be closed on June 27th and 28th.

RETURNING PLAYERS

- Ensure that all required certifications (Respect in Sport, Coaching Certifications, etc.) remain valid. If not, you must renew it before the season starts. Respect in Sport - Parent Certificate should be valid at the time of registration. Please log in to your RIS account and check the date to ensure it does not need to be renewed. This will help when we go to roster the players and will not hold up teams from starting practices.
- 2. You should not have to enter your Hockey ID# to register if you registered last season. Click the registration link, log in to your TeamSnap account, and begin registering.
- 3. You must upload your player's birth certificate and 2 proofs of residency documents.
- 4. Make sure to register before June 30, 2024, to avoid a late fee of \$200.00.
- 5. Begin the Registration Process HERE.

NEW PLAYERS

- 1. Late fees do not apply for new players registering with LMHA for the first time.
- 2. Complete the Mandatory Respect in Sport Parent Program. If you already have a child participating in minor hockey for whom you've completed the Respect in Sport Parent course, you simply have to log in to your Respect in Sport Parent Program(RIS) and add a new player. To do that, log in to your RIS account, click on Profile, click on Child Management, and select ADD CHILD. Be sure to select Lloydminster Minor Hockey as your minor hockey association. This step will create a Hockey Canada ID for your new player. If you have any problems, please contact the Respect in Sport helpline at 1-866-956-9791.
- 3. You will require two Proof of Residency Documents (driver's license, utility bill, etc., showing your name and current residential address within our draw zone boundary zone). These will have to be uploaded into the online registration form.
- 4. Age verification documents (birth certificate or passport) scan and upload into registration where asked.

PLAYERS TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER ASSOCIATION

The following steps must be completed BEFORE beginning the registration process.

- 1. If you are moving or have just moved to Lloydminster from another community, you must complete the Hockey Alberta Online Parent Declaration Form (1 per participant). Please ensure the completed form is submitted to our office. To do this, make sure to enter the following email office @lloydminsterminorhockey.com where it asks for the *Minor Hockey Association Submission* section of the online form; this is important to ensure the transfer process does not get held up. Please make sure all fields are filled out on the form. Hockey Alberta will not approve it if everything is not filled out completely! This will hold up the process time. Before you click submit, check if the proof of address documents (driver's license, utility bill, etc., showing your name and residential address within our boundary) are uploaded. If it doesn't submit and you must go back and enter something that was missed, you will have to upload the documents again. Double-check before you click submit again.
- 2. Email office lloydminsterminorhockey.com to inform us that you have completed the parent declaration form.

Once we receive the above information, we will initiate the player transfer. We will contact you once your player account has been transferred, and then you can proceed to register with LMHA.

A few things that you will need to register your child.

1. Your children's Hockey Canada Hockey ID #

This can be found in your Respect in Sport Account. Click on Profile and Click on Child Management. The ID# should be beside your child's name.

- 2. Ensure that all required certifications (Respect in Sport, Coaching Certifications, etc.) remain valid. If not, you must renew before the season starts.
- 3. The age verification documents (birth certificate or passport) must be uploaded into the registration. We also need 2 proof of address documents for our records.
- 4. Players new to Lloydminster do not have to pay the late fee.

REFUND POLICY

The following amounts will be refunded as per the dates below.

100% of annual fee less a \$75 admin fee - Until September 1st, 2024

80% of the annual fee less a \$75 admin fee - First Skate - October 31st, 2024

60% of the annual fee less a \$75 admin fee - November 1st - November 30th, 2024

40% of the annual fee less a \$75 admin fee - December 1st - December 31st, 2024
