Scheduling

Total games per team are 22.

League Information

- The U11 Tier 1 Teams will be part of the Northern Alberta Interlock League (NAI).
- All teams are required to host 1 weekend which is paid for by that team (ice and referees).
- All round robin weekend games are regular season games.
- Individual stats and standing will not be kept.
- Random draw system used to determine position for League Final Playoff Tournament.

Team Costs

There will be team fees required to be paid to play for this team. The fee's will be determined by the Coaches and Parent group once the team has been selected. Some of the costs included would be the above mentioned "extra weekends" incurred by a host team, extra practice ice if requested, off ice development, etc.

Each family would also need to consider the costs for transportation, accommodations, meals, etc. Please note that bus transportation is not allowed in the current COVID-19 environment.
