



## Lloydminster Minor Hockey Apparel Policy 2013

Defined Apparel:

- Jackets
- Track Suits, Wind Suits
- Hoodie's, Bunny Hugs

We recommend that this apparel shall include anything that is purchased or donated to the team. **The apparel MUST be purchased locally.** The only logo allowed on this apparel is that of Lloydminster Minor Hockey (i.e.: flaming B). **All jackets, track suits, and wind suits** are to be base color black with red or white accent trim. **All hoodie/bunny hugs base color may have the option to be in one of the 3 Lloydminster Minor Hockey colors – red, white or black with the Lloydminster Minor Hockey Logo(i.e.: flaming B) with red, white or black accent trim.** The apparel will be allowed to have the player information on it in embroidery text. The team would be allowed to have their name embroidered on the bottom of the back of the garment (i.e.: Formula Powell Novice Blazers). There will be no other form of text or logos allowed on the garment other than that of the manufacturer.

Any violation of this policy will be subject to the existing Lloydminster Minor Hockey policy of having the evening ice taken away from the offending team (i.e.: equivalent to \$1000.00)

Items not included in this definition of apparel are:

- Hats
- Toques
- Scarves

These items may have the Lloydminster Minor Hockey logo on them but is not required. They will be able to have a sponsor logo on them and be any color the sponsor/team wishes.

We would as well ask that the board instruct the General Manager to have the teams that have put private sponsor names on the back of the garments have them removed in an appropriate time frame. Our rationale for this is that all coaches and managers were aware that this was not allowed prior to the start of the 2011/12 hockey season.

We would require the Elite division to adhere to the purchase local portion of this policy and have the Lloydminster Minor Hockey logo on the exterior of the apparel.
