Zone Reports

- Coquitlam has officially applied for nationals for 2019 and 2020 decision will be made for one year at the May CLA AGM
- Team BC application deadlines
 - Female Bantam and Midget May 3
 - Pee Wee and Bantam boys April 12
 - Midget Team BC camps though the summer game camps
 - There are no coaches committed at this time

- Asked the island to run as two teams and as they are development can combine as one for the provincials
- PTP worked on the forms and hopefully the new manual is easier to read
 - This is to be used for out of your own commission
 - It is not used within your own commission
- Concussion testing was discussed
- Honour the game decals – let Rochelle know if you want them and if you want them there is no cost to the association
- Two appeals – upheld at the Minor Directorate and one is going to the BCLA.
 - If approved there will need to be a review of how players are released
- Commissioner package was in conflict with policy and was updated
- Island is going to a commission wide allocation policy and will try it for this year

- Schedules

- Tournaments
 - Asked the commissions and ask your teams to take a picture of the game sheet and send it to your commissioner after each game
 - Tournament sheets are not always sent promptly to the effected league
 - This also covers you for any players that have served their suspension at away tournaments
 - It can affect your coaches
- Majors in last 10 minutes
 - It is an automatic 1 game suspension for the player
 - There will not any paperwork sent
 - Coaches are responsible to know that the player is ineligible to play
 - Email your commissioner if in doubt
- Team contact
 - If teams have not heard from their commissioner please have them let you know
 - You also have to send the information to the commissioner on your team contacts
- TBR's on the schedule it is up to the home team to reschedule
 - Get it done early in the season
 - All games have to be done by May 6th for the tiering, except for the Junior girls they may not have a break.
- Registration dates
 - Everyone has different dates
 - Would people be willing to go with similar dates
 - People have different dates for different releases
 - Some associations give all releases the early bird rate
- Directories are here to pick up – every association is to take 4
- North Vancouver has lost one of their arenas
