COVID Rules & Regulations for Arena Facilities

- Limitations of participants on an ice pad
- Full ice drills permitted with all skaters
- All coaches must wear a mask while on the ice surface or bench
- Participants are required to wear a mask in the dressing room but can remove it prior to going on the ice.
- Body contact is permitted
- Arena dressing rooms are open with limits on the number in a dressing room with distancing requirements still in place
- Chairs are set out in specific areas and **CAN NOT** be moved
- Please be sure to only utilize the chairs that are assigned for your rink
- Games or scrimmages are permitted
- Each participant may have 2 spectators enter to watch. These spectators are required to complete the City of London screening document upon entry, must watch from the designated spectator viewing area, and must maintain a physical distance of 2 meters from anyone outside their household. We ask that spectators enter at the time of rental and exit immediately after. Masks must be worn at all times.
- Arena access is only permitted 15 minutes before each rental and groups must leave 15 minutes after each rental.
- No outside food or drink is permitted
- **DO NOT** leave any valuables with your belongings, as there will be no way to secure items while you are on the ice. **LEAVE VALUABLES AT HOME.**

Note: Kinsmen Arena only allows spectators in the cold viewing area.
