General

- Please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes prior to your scheduled ice time.
- Entry point for the Pat Duke Memorial Arena is the player's entrance on the north east side of the building.
- Masks are required for all indoor spaces <u>at all times</u> for everyone 5 years of age or older except field of play, which is defined as the bench and ice.
- Children cannot be running around the arena. They must sit with their parent. If these
 kids cannot do that then please make other arrangements so that they are not in the
 rink during practices/games.
- No food allowed in the arena.
- Please maintain the 2m distance from those not in your household.
- All of the arena doors will now be locked. The manager/COVID ambassador(s) will be asking all adults for a valid <u>Vaccine Passport and Identification</u> (2 doses). The QR code provided with vaccine passports will be scanned with the BC Vaccine Card Verifier App. They will continue be asking the COVID related questions below as everyone enters the rink. The door will remain locked once everyone is in the arena to stop other people from wandering in without being checked.
- Youth Sports Participants (21 years of age and younger) are exempt from proof of vaccination.

Covid Related Questions:

- Are you experiencing any of these symptoms?
 - Fever, chills, cough or worsening of chronic cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell or taste, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
- Have you returned from travel outside Canada in the last 14 days?
- Are you a confirmed contact with a person that has Covid?
- A "yes" to any of the above questions will not permit the individual to enter the building.
