### LUMBY MONASHEE CLASSIC 2024 - U15 TOURNAMENT RULES

### Format

4 games guaranteed (3 round robin games and 1 playoff game guaranteed)

#### Rules

- All games played under Hockey Canada, BC Hockey and OMAHA rules. •
- This is a **NON-CONTACT** tournament. •
- Players will **NOT** be allowed on the ice unless they are wearing full gear including a BNQ approved throat guard/neck guard.
- All teams should be **ready to play 10 minutes before** the game start time. •

### Responsibilities

Coaches and Managers are responsible for team behaviour in the hallways and ensuring the dressing rooms are cleaned up. The Head Coach will be held responsible for any mess left behind and/or damage caused to the dressing room.

#### Scheduling

If the tournament gets behind schedule, the Tournament Director/Organizer can and will adjust the remaining ice ٠ times at his/her own discretion.

#### Home Team

The home team will be the first team listed on the schedule. The home team will wear light coloured jerseys, but will be responsible to change jerseys if there is a colour conflict. The home team should remain on the ice until the visiting team has left the ice.

#### Ice Clean

- An ice clean will occur halfway through the game.
- An ice clean will occur after every game.

#### **MVP/Heart & Hustle Awards**

"MVP" and "Heart & Hustle" awards will be handed out at the end of each game. The Head Coach will pick for their own team.

### Match Penalty or Gross Misconduct

- Any player receiving a Gross Misconduct or Match Penalty will be suspended as per BC Hockey Suspension Guidelines.
- Team officials fall under the same rules as players.
- The Officials or Tournament Volunteers do not determine the suspensions nor do they have ability to access this information. If a suspension is given, the information about the suspension will be sent directly to the President of the players Association and it is their responsibility to share the information with the Head Coach.

#### Penalties

- Run Time:
  - o 3 Mins Minor
  - 6 Mins Double Minor
  - 7.5 Mins Major

- Stop Time:
- o 2 Mins Minor 4 Mins – Double Minor
- 0 o 5 Min - Major

#### Protests

• No protests will be permitted. All decisions of the referees and/or tournament director are final.

### **On Ice Officials**

- Decisions made by the on-ice officials will be final.
- There will be NO TOLERANCE by officials with respect to abuse and disputed calls. •
- At times, an on-ice mentor will be present to assist our young officials, who are still learning. This mentor has the authority to make calls and over-ride the calls of our young officials.

### Verbal or Physical Abuse

Verbal or physical abuse of players, spectators, coaches, or any tournament officials WILL NOT be tolerated. Anyone disregarding this policy will be asked to leave the arena.

#### Timing of Games – Round Robin Play

- 3 x 20-minute periods of RUN time, except during major injury.
- The Tournament Committee and LMHA will shorten warm-up time or use running time at any time during round-robin play to ensure the tournament runs on schedule.
- Pre-game warm up will be 5 minutes and will begin at the noted start time of the game. (PLEASE BE ON TIME)
- Warm ups will be shorten if behind schedule
- 1 minute rest between periods
- Ice clean will be done halfway through the second period
- 5 minutes at the end of the game for presentation of Heart and Hustle Award
- No overtime in round-robin play

### **Round Robin Points System**

- 2 Points will be awarded for a win
- 1 Point for each team if the game ends in a tie
- 0 Points for a loss

### Ties after Round Robin (OMAHA Tie Breaking Procedure 1.22)

- In the event Teams are tied for a playoff position after a Round Robin series is completed, the following procedure shall be utilized to determine the placing of the tied teams:
- a) If two (2) teams are tied, the winner of the Round Robin game between those two (2) teams will receive the higher placing. If three
  (3) or more teams are tied, the team which has accumulated the most points in games against the tied teams will receive the highest placing, the team with the next most points in games against the tied teams will receive the next highest placing, and so on.
- b) If any teams remain tied after (a) has been applied, then the Team with the most wins in the round robin series (note that this includes all games in the round robin series and is not limited to games between the tied teams only) will receive the higher placing, and so on.
- c) If any teams remain tied after (a) and (b) have been applied, then the team with the best goal average in games between the tied teams will receive the higher placing, and so on. The goal average of the teams is to be determined by dividing the total number of goals for and against into the total number of goals for, with the Team having the highest percentage will be awarded the higher position.
- d) If any teams remain tied after (a), (b) and (c) have been applied, then the team with the best goal average in the round robin series (note that this includes all games in the round robin series and is not limited to games between the tied teams only) will receive the higher placing, and so on. The goal average of a team is to be determined by dividing the total number of goals for and against into the total number of goals for, with the Team having the highest percentage will be awarded the higher position. (Example: Goals for 10, goals against 4; percentage is 10/14 = .714). In determining the goal average the maximum goal differential that may be applied in any single game shall be seven (7).
- e) If any teams remain tied after (a), (b), (c) and (d) the team that received the least minutes in penalties in the round robin games between the tied teams will receive the higher placing, and so on.
- f) If teams are still tied after all previous methods have been applied, then the winner of the playoff position will be decided by the toss of a coin.

### Sunday Semifinals and Championship - Playoff Games

#### **Timing of Games**

Games will be 1:45 minute in length 1st period - 20 minute of run time 2nd period - 10 minutes of run time to half mark and the remaining 10 minutes will be stop time 3rd period - 20 minute of stop time 5 minute warm up (PLEASE BE ON TIME) 1 minute rest between periods Ice clean will be done halfway through the second period 5 minutes for presentation of Heart and Hustle Awards

#### Overtime

Overtime rules ONLY for Semi-Finals and Championship Games:

- One (1) 5-minute sudden victory overtime period of 4 skaters on 4 skaters, stop time.
- If a game is remained tied after applying (a), then one (1) 5-minute sudden victory overtime period of 3 skaters on 3 skaters, stop time.
