



## Jersey Policy

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1. MRA requires all players to purchase their own jerseys to wear for the season. Players may reuse them until the jerseys are too small or worn out.
2. Each Player is required to own a Home & Away sublimated jersey. (Mandatory for U10-U19 any R4U age advanced players to U10)
3. Optional to players is to have last name sublimated on the jersey so you will not need to purchase name bars and affix them to the jersey.
4. Once a player selects a number it is their number if still in the sport, until that particular age group/birth year leaves the system. This means a player born in 2009 will have their number reserved until the end of the 2027-2028 season. Ex Player is #3 at U12 club level and then makes AA plays two seasons at AA, returns to Club level the following season their number #3 is theirs. If a player wishes to change numbers (if the number is available) they will be required to purchase a new jersey. This can only be done at the beginning of the season.
5. If a player leaves the sport at any time, their number is not guaranteed if they return to the sport.
6. Jerseys cannot be worn on a team where the number is already assigned – in other words: each number on a team must be a unique number.
7. Anyone wishing to buy a used jersey or sell a jersey needs to notify MRA so that MRA can maintain the player number registry and ensure no duplication of numbers within the age groups. If a player plans to sell a used jersey, they may want to consider whether they sublimated their name onto the jersey or just use a namebar.
8. Jerseys must fit properly, be in good shape - i.e. have no rips, torn seams, not faded etc. If using a namebar, namebar color scheme must match the jerseys of the rest of the team.
9. Jerseys are the responsibility of the players. Lost jerseys to be replaced by the players.
10. MRA mandates the jersey be presentable and replaced if required at the cost of the player.
11. Coaches will be responsible for the spare jerseys provided by MRA. A team deposit will be required at the beginning of the season. Spare jerseys to be used for temporary players (TP) or if a player forgot their jersey. They are not to be used by one player for the whole season unless permission has been granted by MRA.
12. Players without a jersey will not be able to play in league games. (Unless approved by MRA)
13. MRA will hold fittings prior to each season to try on jerseys.
14. Jerseys to be ordered at registration time online. Jerseys can be reused from year to year, and new jerseys may be ordered should a player grow out of a size between seasons.



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15. Jersey orders are non-refundable.
16. R4U will continue to use Timbit Jerseys.

## NUMBER DISTRIBUTION

17. Players will pick five numbers. Players will rank the five numbers in order of preference. With #1 being first pick and 5th being last pick.
18. Once a player is assigned a number that number will not be available until that player does not overlap with birth year. Example - 2003 player picks #5 and is assigned #5. This number would not be available for any players born in 2001, 2002, 2004 & 2005. It would come available for anyone in 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011
19. Numbers will be assigned based on order of paid registration for the season.
20. Request for numbers will be done at registration online.
21. If numbers are not picked or numbers picked are not from block assigned, MRA may assign a number to the player.
22. If MRA cannot assign a player one of the six numbers they choose, MRA may contact the player.
