



**MMHA Code of Conduct**  
**2024-2025 Season**

All parents of MMHA players are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner that embodies:

- Trustworthiness
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Integrity
- Good citizenship

While registered with MMHA, I recognize that both my child and I represent MMHA and the community of Macklin. I will ensure my behaviour reflects positively on both the organization and the community at all hockey functions both at home and in other communities.

As a parent of a child registered with MMHA, I pledge:

- I will encourage and support my child's desire to play hockey.
- I will not embarrass my child by yelling at players, coaches, or officials.
- I will treat all players, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators with respect and courtesy. I will refrain from any behaviour or comments which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive. This includes taunting or booing, refusing to shake hands or using profane language or gestures.
- I will support and promote Fair Play by encouraging my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will strive to become knowledgeable about the rules of the game and support the official's decisions on and off the ice.
- I will support and promote all rules, regulations and guidelines laid out by Hockey Saskatchewan in regards to game play, player affiliation, ineligible players, etc.
- I will recognize the importance of volunteer coaches and will take the time to attend team meetings to get to know my child's coach's philosophy, expectations, and guidelines. I will communicate with my child's coaches and support them.
- I will inform the coach of any physical ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I will not yell instructions to my child from the sidelines or give my child instructions counter to those of the coach. I understand that when my child is on the ice, the coaches do the coaching.
- I understand that it is my role to teach my child sportsmanship, how to deal with success and failure, and to support my child's development in the game.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- I will respect locker rooms as private areas for players, coaches, and officials.
- I will refrain from the use of drugs, tobacco and alcohol at all MMHA events.
- I will respect the facilities used by MMHA and any facilities I may visit while representing MMHA. This includes following all rules/regulations of said facilities.
- I will respect and follow the guidelines within the MMHA constitution.
