TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

- Hotel costs at the Red Deer tournament are included in the player fee. Each player has a room to share with family within the team hotel block.
- Players and families are responsible only for transportation to and from both tournaments.
- Hotel booking details and reservation instructions will be shared following team selection.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens after tryouts?

Selected athletes and families will be invited to a parent information meeting. This meeting will review program expectations, travel information, hotel block details, apparel sizing, fundraising opportunities, code of conduct, and next steps.

How are players evaluated?

Athletes will be assessed through a structured evaluation process involving multiple evaluators and coaches. Players will be reviewed on skill, effort, coachability, positional understanding, team play, and overall readiness for the Team Manitoba environment.

Are fundraising opportunities available?

Yes. Fundraising opportunities will be shared with selected families. Any fundraising information, deadlines, and credit process will be communicated after team selection.

What is included in the player fee?

The approximate fee includes apparel, Prairie Cup tournament registration, player meals, snacks, hydration, practices and preparation sessions, coaching and team staff support, team hotel coordination, and one hotel room per player shared with their family.

Are hotels included at both tournaments?

Hotel accommodations for the Prairie Cup in Red Deer are included. Each player has a room to share with family within the Team Manitoba hotel block. In Halifax, hotel block has been secured, but is not included.

Do families need to stay in the team hotel block?

Yes. Families are expected to stay within the Team Manitoba hotel block to support team logistics, supervision, scheduling, player meals, and the overall team experience.

Who is responsible for transportation?

Players and families are responsible for transportation to and from Red Deer. MLA will coordinate the hotel block and team schedule during the event.

When will hotel details be provided?

Hotel booking details and reservation instructions will be shared following team selection.

Where do athletes register?

Registration is open online through the Manitoba Lacrosse Association website.

SELECTION PROCESS + NEXT STEPS

Evaluations are completed by multiple evaluators and coaches. Following tryouts, selections will be reviewed and invitations will be extended.
