# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **What happens after tryouts?**

Selected athletes and families will be invited to a parent information meeting. This meeting will review program expectations, travel information, hotel block details, apparel sizing, fundraising opportunities, code of conduct, and next steps.

## **How are players evaluated?**

Athletes will be assessed through a structured evaluation process involving multiple evaluators and coaches. Players will be reviewed on skill, effort, coachability, positional understanding, team play, and overall readiness for the Team Manitoba environment.

## **Are fundraising opportunities available?**

Yes. Fundraising opportunities will be shared with selected families. Any fundraising information, deadlines, and credit process will be communicated after team selection.

## **What is included in the player fee?**

The approximate fee includes Nationals registration, flights, hotel accommodations, ground transportation in Oshawa, all team meals, snacks, hydration, practices and preparation sessions, coaching and team staff support, and team travel logistics during the event.

## **Are all hotel accommodations and meals included?**

Yes. Hotel accommodations at Nationals are included. All team meals, snacks and hydration during the events are also included.

## **Do families need to book or pay for anything?**

No. Team Manitoba will handle all hotel bookings and payments. Families do not need to book or pay for hotels.

## **Where do athletes register?**

Registration is open online through the Manitoba Lacrosse Association website.

## **SELECTION PROCESS + NEXT STEPS**

Evaluations are completed by multiple evaluators and coaches. Following tryouts, selections will be reviewed and invitations will be extended.

Selected families will receive details on payment, fundraising, hotel blocks, apparel sizing, code of conduct, and travel requirements.
