Re: Youth to Senior Guest Permit – Form Update

Dear Members,

The Manitoba Soccer Association (MSA) would like to inform you that there have been important updates to the Youth to Senior Guest Permit form per the MSA Rules and Regulations. Going forward, this form, which is used by Senior Club Officials to call up a Youth Player to play with their Senior Club for a single game, will now reflect the following changes:

- will be a single form which can be filled out and printed with a computer prior to the match and signed accordingly;
- require the Initials of the Youth Club Official to certify having received written permission from the Youth's Parent/Guardian allowing him/her to participate in the game;
- include Part C, which is to be filled out by a Registered Senior Club Official who has a clear and completed CPIC and to be in attendance at the game;
- form to be submitted by the Referee to the Senior League attached with the Game Sheet;
- Referee and Opposite Senior Club to take a photo of the form for their records.
