Scott Pump 2019-20 Season Recap



But it taught us what it meant to play for each other instead of for ourselves. The individual efforts and tendencies were highlighted. The negative attitudes and poor efforts began to disappear. We needed to hit rock bottom in order to get over the hump and see success.

December was our most successful month of season. We began to learn from our past mistakes and the development of our players became evident. It began with a wild 9-8 victory! More lessons came that night, as we thought the game was over when we had a 7-3 lead. Beaumont tied the game at 8-8 before we capitalized on the very next faceoff. Stress! With a pair of ties in the next two games, we would finish on back-to-back wins for an undefeated 3-0-2 month heading into Christmas.

December was capped off with the annual EBIT tournament. I believe this was the weekend that turned us from a "team" into a "family". Two come-from-behind victories and a thrilling 7-6 win over the 1st place CAC Alumni found us in the #1 see in our division. Unfortunately, our prize was a matchup against the undefeated Lakeland Panthers. Though we lost the game, the night was topped off by goaltender Erika Lind winning one of the annual EBIT scholarships!

January kept us on a torrid pace, finishing with a 5-2 record. Four straight victories saw us outscore opponents 25-6. This left us with a combined December/January record of 11-3-2. Capping off the month was the Pink game, seeing us defeat CAC by a score of 4-3. (P.S. Please never let CAC wear red jerseys on Pink night ever again. What a nightmare!)

Unfortunately for us, we ran out of gas in February. The month started with 3 games in 3 nights, giving us just 2 of a possible 6 points. Heartbreaking losses to \$1. Albert and KC saw us drop a few standings positions, and we finished in the 6th seed. To our demise, all of our scoring touch was used up in January, and we couldn't buy a goal in the playoffs. A truly tough ending to what we believe was a real successful season.

In my final speech to the players, all I could talk about was how proud I was of them. I told them at the beginning of the season that I wanted to develop them both on and off the ice, and I feel the lessons learned have helped them accomplish that. It's difficult not to be emotional while writing this. Myself and our staff have grown a connection and care with each and every one of these amazing young men and women. I'm so excited to see what the future holds for every single one of them. I can only hope that they look back in 10 years and remember what a wonderful season we had as the 2019-20 Bantam AA Alumni.

To all our players...Number 1, I'm proud of all of you for what you accomplished this year. Number 2...that's a big win boys!

The MLAC Traxx Bantam AA Hockey Club coaching staff would like to thank the players, parents, families, the organization, and all of our sponsors and supporters for a memorable first season as a coaching staff. Without the support and belief in our approach to the game and our players, this season would not have been as successful as it has been so far.

As a staff, we were aware of the struggles that teams had in past years, and it was our goal to help change the perception of MLAC hockey to opposing teams. All 4 of the coaches on this team grew up playing for MLAC and it was our desire to give back to the club that gave us opportunities as young players. We didn't want to be seen as a team that was "an easy 2 points" and we took steps to avoid that from happening. By utilizing systems that are more popular in European hockey, our goal was to bring a style of hockey that many opposing coaches hadn't seen. We knew that there would be challenges with this as well, because players hadn't learned it in the past, a challenge that we were willing to deal with. Very early on, we told our players to "not be afraid to make mistakes, and that if you are going to make a mistake, make it a big one." We would rather see the players fail in an attempt than not take a chance at all.

Like every team, there were some ups and downs, some big wins, some tough losses. The one thing about this group that we are impressed by, is how they came together as a team and became more of a family down the final stretch of the season. There was a shift in team dynamic, and the boys realized that in order to succeed together, you have to play together. This shift happened on December 20 at our pink game, a game that we came in to at 5 games below .500 (6-11-2). Our boys went out and played a great game for a worthy cause, one especially significant this season. Our boys ended up tying that game 2-2 against a team that would eventually finish first in our division. Our last 13 games we went 5-5-3, scoring 40 goals and only allowing 37, finishing our season at 11-16-5, in 5th spot in our division. It was our pleasure to have the opportunity to help coach and develop these young men into better players, and hopefully give them skills that transition into success in their lives outside of hockey.

As a staff, we would like to leave the boys with a quote to consider: "The biggest risk is not taking any risk... In a world that's changing really quickly, the only strategy that is guaranteed to fail is not taking risks."























