### What Does Practice Look Like at This Level?

At the Fun 1 & Fun 2 levels, practices are structured, energetic, and skill-focused — while keeping FUN at the centre of everything we do!

#### EACH SESSION INCLUDES:

- Skating fundamentals (balance, edges, speed, agility)
- Ring control and passing skills
- Shooting basics
- Small-area games to build teamwork
- Introduction to positional play
- Confidence-building activities

Practices are designed to keep players moving and engaged the entire time. At this stage, we emphasize skill development, teamwork, and sportsmanship in a fun, encouraging atmosphere.

### Coaching & Support

- Two dedicated coaches
