



Marpole Soccer Club Society Constitution

The name of the Society is MARPOLE SOCCER CLUB SOCIETY

The purposes of the Society are:

- a. To promote, enhance, further, and develop in the City of Vancouver the game of soccer as a recreational as well as competitive activity, and to do all things necessary, usual or desirable for such purpose or purposes, and without restricting the generality of the foregoing, but for greater certainty, the Society may:
 - i. from time to time acquire by gift, devise, bequest, transfer, purchase or otherwise, real and personal property and dispose of the same or any part thereof by sale, transfer, mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise with the proceeds acquire other property
 - ii. erect, equip, provide, furnish, maintain and manage such facilities as may be deemed necessary therefore, either alone or jointly with other organizations;
 - iii. employ instructors, trainers, managers, coaches, officials and such persons may be though advisable, and to conduct or assist in the conducting of clinics for the training, assistance and guidance of such instructors, trainers, managers, coaches and officials;
 - iv. to supply rule books, equipment and all such resources necessary or as may be though advisable for any of the aforesaid purposes;
 - v. raise funds to carry out the above purposes by means of: a. solicitation of money from corporations and individuals; b. the carrying on business activities provided such businesses are permitted under the Society Act from time to time in force and provided such business activities are permitted to a charitable organization under the Income Tax Act from time to time in force.
 - vi. raise money by any other lawful means and give security therefore for any of the above purposes;
 - vii. do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objectives;
- b. To assist all members or groups of members forming leagues or divisions;
 - i. by providing arbitration and making regulations to govern all disputes or differences between members forming leagues or divisions;
 - ii. by acquiring and transmitting information between members or groups of members forming leagues or divisions and any other person, group, or governmental body having an interest in the further promotion and development of Soccer.

- c. To provide leadership and guidance in the development of leagues or divisions at various levels of Soccer and to encourage and develop membership in such leagues or division
- d. To provide assistance to and cooperate with any person, group, organization, society, company or association, whose aim it is to further promote and develop the game of Soccer.
