Criminal Record Check- Vulnerable Sector Information

FMRA volunteers who work with children are required to get a Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check. This service is free if you bring the attached signed letter to the RCMP office when you apply.

You must apply for the record check in person at the address below. Make sure that the spelling of your name on the letter is the same as your official identification. Two pieces of identification are required; one must be a valid government issued photo ID and the other needs to have your name (same name as on your government issued ID).

STEPS FOR GETTING FMRA LETTER WITH SIGNATURE

- 1. Open the letter in a PDF editor such as Adobe Acroblat or Foxit Editor or use a free Internet Browser such as Google Chrome.
- 2. Type your first and last name in the "name field".
- Save the file as: *lastname-firstname-year-CRC.PDF* for example: Boger-Tracy-2022-CRC.PDF
- 4. Email the file to: volunteer@mcmurrayringette.com
- 5. If approved a signed letter will be emailed within one week (but usually much sooner at the beginning of the season).
