Donnie — Would the Association save \$ on banking fees if we were to role the \$200 levy money over to the next season for returning families. Kristy- Can they be refunded on RAMP and post the credit? Brianna — We can test it! Refund on pants will be about \$3000. Can we confirm that goalies completed 90% commitment for reimbursement of fees? Sara — Need to figure out how to get ex-players to stay involved in the Association. Graduating players continuing education scholarship/ bursary? Donnie-Should include a minimum of 5 years with the Association to be eligible. Sara- I don't think that it was set up this year but could be an AGM discussion point for next year. Brianna- Anticipate a big loss this year. We had \$30,000 profit from Casino. This year, with 2 x Jersey purchase orders, on paper, we will show the loss. Casino money will be all used up this year. Casino money is usually spent on ice and refs. Won't be eligible for another Casino for 18 months. 4 more sheets of ice for May (yesterday, today and 2 upcoming time slots). Ice is now hard to find, got rid of M1.
