DISCUSSION: Trevor reached out to Mel Thomas to do a 2-day workshop for U12 and above. Two sessions each team x 6 teams. 12 sessions total. \$4400. January 25th and 26th. Mel Thomas is a high-end Ringette instructor. Very knowledgable. Training sells out . Lots of ice that weekend. Kristy- Will that take away from BGL? Rachel will have to be creative trading some ice. It will be great for the players and coaches. We don't get this up here. Fantastic idea. Will run a coaches session. \$12,000 in Player Development. \$2000 for Goalie Development. Jay Duffett came out. Reached out to three Goalies. Hard to get anyone. Mark Wait coaches Hockey. Mel wants to make this a yearly thing and come up September / October every year. Brianna- has to be paid up front. Allie Wait has a cousin that plays for WAM and will bring players from WAM to come here. Sean- All ice gone. Black out dates 15th. Need to make decision. Coaches this year and last year that don't have the training needed to coach. Trying to bring up Beth December 7th and 8th. Looking @ online training. Will we have to pay a few to RAB? Kristy-No. Coaches Training: 9 signed up for CI and 2 signed up for CSI. Looking at on-ice assistants to move up. Kristy- Is Bryson junior coaching? Registered as a Player but not on a roster. Hasn't asked for a refund. Sean- Not signed up for courses (CI). Kristy- reach out to Jeff about getting a refund and register to a Coach Clinic. Trevor and Jeff are doing CSI. After December, Trevor can host Coaching Clinics.
