Rachel- Already in Ice Allocation, already included in ice allocation. Reached out to Trevor and Sean about limitations, given the green light to get ice. Interested in cost. Kristy-Interested in calculation basing Registration off ice costs. Rachel- Below. Kristy- Already have Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Rachel- We could give it back, people would take it. Kristy- What teams will we put there? Rachel- What Coaches will be willing to fill in? Looking for direction. Spring Break February 24-28. Laura- Market it as extra development for several hours. Rachel- Originally that was the plan but don't think it has come through. Rachel- Can reach out to Head Coaches to see who is available. Has always been told not to give ice back. Jeff- Minor Hockey doesn't want it. Kristy- No one is going to be here! Will waste it on 5 kids. Rachel- Can release it and won't be billed. Jeff- Throw out Survey Monkey to see who will be here for February Break. 60% or release it. Can we implement a rotation of the Thursday @ 5:30 ice time through the 14/16 and 19 teams? Jeff- Thursday 5:30 ice. Burnt vacation time to run it. No Coaches available. Can take it twice a month. Can we rotate it through other Teams when I'm working so I'm not using all of my vacation time? Rachel- Trying to be consistent. Ice for Power Skating Tuesday U12, Thursday wonky Anzac ice. Monday 5:30 – 6:30, Tuesday 6:30, Wednesday 8-9. Jeff- I'll take twice a month. Not fair to take it all the time. Rachel- Don't know what to do. Impossible to make everyone happy. Jenn- U19 half or more of the players have jobs. Jeff- 6:30-7:30 Tuesday can make work x 4 more practices for BGL Teams. Start shift on Thursday and have to take 3 hours of vacation each practice. Rachel- Send me your schedule. Have people asking same thing. If everyone is on board, don't think U12C will care. Jeff- Only February and March, can make it work. Rachel- Can talk to Trevor and Sean. Trinidy- Can make it work as well. Rachel-75% Goalie rule. Have a goalie that has played 10 games. Can we round up? Play the goalie all the time? Been told can only play 75%. Jeff- Dress the goalie and play full game. It's children's ringette.

A combination of things not lining up. Ask for courtesy of letting Association know. Rachel- Should have asked more questions when Adam emailed about Step 3. Trevor-The girls had time sitting around and we could have planned it better to make better use of their time. Caroyn- Clearly there are things happing in the Association that we don't know about. Fill out a form. Rachel- ex. Prestige Jewellers Debacle. Trinidy- Working on a document on duty and expectations. Caroyn- Already exists. Google docs? Trinidy- Looked at the Website, not sure of where it is posted. Caroyn- Flow chart system of operations. Trinidy- Noticing more as the Association grows. More chaos. Donny- Finland Trip- Is this a private event for Trevor's group? Heard from another parent who is upset about it. Trevor- It has nothing to do with the Ringette Association. Jeff took a Team. Fort McMurray Ringette Travel Team. Kristy- Can they use our logo on Jerseys? It was a disaster. Booked own ice. Own Board, Own Insurance. Donny going back to this parent with information. Jeff open to discuss with Donny and Parent. Jenn- not sanctioned same way. If that parent wants to get Coaches and Players and put in a team, they can! Trevor- Sent a parent a pamphlet with the information. Anyone is free to make a team. Donny- Confirming FMRA not making a team. Tammy (Forwarded question)- Question brought forward form Managers at Round Table wondering if something could be put in place to "borrow" money from the Association while waiting for the arrival of grants such as Suncares? For instance if prrof is shown that the grant has been approved and donated to FMRA, could they receive the money and then the Association just keep the Grant when it arrives? Sean- We discussed this before about Suncares money. My opinion is we should pay out upon confirmation of deposit from Suncor. My question to prompt this last year was "has Suncor never not paid once confirmation happened?" The answer I received was no. If we know the money will get there, let the teams have access. Let them develop their teams early in the season instead of waiting until February to spend a bunch of money.
