## **8 – GAMING**

### **8.1 Distribution of Proceeds**

The Association has access to two vehicles on an ongoing basis to provide funding support for Ringette. Casinos and Raffles are ways of reducing the cost of participating in Ringette.

- a. Proceeds from Casinos and Raffles are designated to assist in paying for Capital Expenditures, particularly the purchase of ice and Referees;
- b. Proceeds from Casinos and Raffles are intended to defray some of the ongoing operating costs of Ringette;
- c. Any surplus proceeds are to be used to the general advantage of the Association;
- d. From time to time, the Executive may adjust the manner and amount of distribution of gaming proceeds;
- e. All proceeds are to be distributed and used in a manner consistent with the rules and regulations of the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission. In no case shall a member receive a cash benefit from participation in the Gaming Program.

### **8.2 Fundraising Coordinator**

The Fundraising Coordinator is responsible for the operation of the Gaming Program. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to:

- a. All applications for gaming licences, routine contact with gaming officials and provision of all required information to the Provincial Government or appointed Agencies;
- b. Recruiting and ensuring members are properly trained to work at these events;
- c. Representation of the Association with Gaming Associations;
- d. Providing information, reports and recommendations to the Executive as requested;
- e. Any other activities to ensure a successful Gaming Program.
