## Permission to Consider Player for a Higher Division

To balance the number of players in each division, and to attempt to have as many girls playing ringette as possible, it is occasionally necessary for MDRA to ask that some players play in the next higher division (e.g. a petite player being asked to play tween). Since the Ringette Canada rules specify only maximum ages for divisions and not minimum, this is completely within the rules of ringette. MDRA's policy is that only players in the oldest year of their native division are considered for moving up.

You, and all parents of players in the oldest year of your daughter's division, are being asked to complete and sign this form. Its purpose is to inform the MDRA executive of which players may be considered for moving up to the next division. Please indicate below either "yes" or "no" that the MDRA executive may consider moving your daughter up. Indicating "yes" in no way implies that your player will play in the higher division.
