

THE # 1 QUESTION WE RECEIVE IS WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN BLASTBALL AND TBALL

..AND WHERE SHOULD MY CHILD GO????

Hopefully we can clarify:

Blastball vs Tball

Both leagues are CO-ED - teams consist of both boys and girls, as even as possible.

Play:

Blastball: Monday nights ONLY

Tball: Tuesday AND Thursday nights

Time:

Blastball: 6:00 - 6:45

Tball: 6:15 - 7:15

Cost:

Blastball: \$65

Tball: \$110 + \$50 Volunteer Commitment Cheque

Includes:

Blastball: T-shirt, Windup

Tball: T-shirt

Ages:

Blastball: Must be 3 years old on or before April 30th, 2019 and not be 5 years old on or before April 30th, 2019. (2016, 2015, 2014 - DEPENDING ON AGE BY POSTED REQUIREMENTS *see note below)

Tball: 2013/2014 (IF YOUR CHILD IS BORN IN 2013 OR 2014 THEY CAN PLAY TBALL!)

THERE ARE NO 3 YEAR OLDS IN TBALL: NO EXCEPTIONS.

Equipment:

Blastball: Foam equipment - bat and ball. (base HONKS!)

Tball: REAL equipment: metal bats, real softballs, regular bases.

Blastball: NO glove required, but can bring.

Tball: GLOVE and HELMET required!

Other:

Blastball: **** PARENT INVOLMENT IS MANDATORY!****

Tball: Parents are needed to lend a hand, but the coaches do the primary amount of skill building and game plays.

Blastball: ONLY 1 base is used, emphasis is on FUN and basic skills. Quick transitions

Tball: FULL diamond used. Emphasis is still on fun, and learning to play. Longer drills - and games.

****GREY AREA BEING CHILREN BORN MAY - DEC 2014, AS THEY ARE NOT 5 BY APRIL 30TH, 2019 - SO THEY CAN PLAY BLASTBALL, BUT BEING BORN IN 2014 THEY CAN PLAY TBALL. PLEASE CHOOSE WHICH DIVISION WOULD BEST BENEFIT YOUR CHILD.**

Do you have a child that could play in either league???

Ask yourself questions like: Will my child enjoy playing twice a week? Is my child large or small for their age? Does my child gravitate to older or younger children? Is my child very shy or outgoing? Does my child take direction well? Do I feel comfortable with my child playing with a metal bat and real softball? Can my child hold a glove? Would my child be confused by only 1 base? Would my child feel comfortable with a coach?
