### Congratulations

- Fist bumps will be allowed at the tournament at the end of each game, please have athletes keep on their gloves.

### Tournament Office

### Awards Procedure

- U10 - All athletes will receive a medal. Coaches will receive the medals at check in and can distribute to teams.
- U12-U19 - An Ed Horvath Tournament Committee Member will be present at the Gold Medal game to present the Gold and Silver medals to the coaches of the teams.
- Open - An Ed Horvath Tournament Committee Member will be present at the final game to present the prize cheques to the coaches of the teams.
- All teams in the finals games will be permitted to take photos on the ice with their medals.

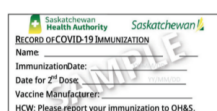
## Provincial Covid-19 Safety Measures

All recreation facilities in Medicine Hat are participating in the Alberta Restriction Exemption Program, meaning that all spectators 12 years old and up will require proof of vaccination to enter. Below are samples of the accepted proof of vaccination records:

Athletes participating in the tournament, under the age of 18, are not required to provide proof of vaccination.
