



## **Medicine Hat Ringette Association Official of the Year Nomination**

### **Philosophy**

Medicine Hat Ringette Association may award one Official of the Year award at the end of each season. The selected official will have demonstrated a strong performance and commitment to the sport of Ringette through active participation and involvement. Criteria for this award include: level of contribution, longevity of service, impact on the sport, demonstration of excellence; attitude; and peer feedback. Both Senior and Junior Officials are eligible for this award.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- ❖ Current MHRA Member in Good Standing.
- ❖ Currently registered as an Official with Ringette Alberta.
- ❖ A solid understanding of the rules.
- ❖ Consistent and fair rule application during games and from game to game.
- ❖ A professional attitude when dealing with players, team staff members, spectators, and fellow officials.
- ❖ Appropriate manner that best represents all officials both on and off the ice.

### **Process**

- ❖ Any MHRA member may nominate an Official.
- ❖ Include a letter describing why this Official deserves the Official of the Year Award.
- ❖ Include a letter of support from any other MHRA Member.

### **Selection Process**

The Selection Committee will review nominations. Selection will be based on demonstrated excellence in officiating throughout the season he/she is nominated.
