	The RASC Director has the authority and responsibility to oversee the RASC Soccer Program.
Qualifications and Skills:	To effectively fulfill the role of Mini Director an individual must possess strong communication skills and have experience serving on volunteer boards. Ideally, they have volunteered within the Mini Soccer Program for a minimum of two years.

Term:	Directors are elected by the membership at the Annual General Meeting. Directors serve for a two-year term. Directors may be released at the end of the elected term, by resigning or according to the MHSA Bylaws.
General Duties: Specific Duties:	<ul> <li>A Director is fully informed on organizational matters and participates in the Board's deliberations and decisions in matters of policy, finance, programs, personnel and advocacy.</li> <li>The Director must: <ol> <li>Approve, where appropriate, policy and other recommendations received from the Board, its standing committees and staff.</li> <li>Monitor all Board policies.</li> <li>Review the bylaws and policy manual and recommend bylaw changes to the membership.</li> <li>Review the Board's structure, approve changes, and prepare necessary bylaw amendments.</li> <li>Participate in the development of the MHSA's organizational plan and annual review.</li> <li>Approve the MHSA's budget.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Approve the hiring and release of staff, including their employment contracts, based on the recommendation of the Executive Committee.</li> <li>Support and participate in evaluating association staff.</li> <li>Assist in developing and maintaining positive relations among the Board, committees, staff members, and community to enhance the MHSA's mission.</li> </ul>
