Minimum two females on the field during game play. If a team does not have enough, they play down 1 player. *If teams have 1 or less females on the field, it stays 9v9*

Ways to Restart a Game

After a Save...

Penalty Shot..

A goalie may kick or throw the ball out of his/her goal area.

THROW IN... the ball is over the head with two hands, both feet remain on the ground. The team who did not touch the ball last before it went out takes the throw in.

If the ball goes out of bounds at the end of the field, and the defending player touched it last, it is put back in play by a **CORNER KICK**.

If the ball goes out of bounds at the end of the field, and the attacking player touched it last, it is put back in play by a **GOAL KICK**.

If a player commits any of the typical fouls in the penalty area (keepers area) the Referee may award a **Penalty Shot** or Direct Shot on goal with a goalkeeper from the Penalty Mark (12 Yards away).
