WAYS TO RESTART THE GAME

After a Save... A goalie may kick or throw the ball out of his/her goal area.

Ball out of Bounds Over Sideline... **THROW IN**...the ball is over the head with two hands, both feet remain

on the ground. The team who did not touch the ball last before it went

out takes the throw in.

Ball Out of Bounds Over End of Field... If the ball goes out of bounds at the end of the field, and the defending

player touched it last, it is put back in play by a **CORNER KICK**.

Ball Out of Bounds Over End of Field... If the ball goes out of bounds at the end of the field, and the attacking

player touched it last, it is put back in play by a **GOAL KICK.**

Penalty Shot... If a player commits any of the typical fouls in the penalty area (keepers

area) the Referee may award a **Penalty Shot** or Direct Shot on goal

with a goalkeeper from the Penalty Mark (12 Yards away).
