

### RETURNING NON-ACTIVE OFFICIALS

#### **CSA Referee Regulations**

#### 19.3 Registration

f) A Referee who has failed to register as a Referee with Canada Soccer for 2 consecutive seasons shall not be re-registered until an application has been considered by the Member Association within whose area the Referee resides at the time of application for re-registration.

Past officials who have been inactive in registration for longer than 2 seasons, will follow the below pathway to return to active status in Alberta. This will fulfill registration and liability requirements, as well as provide the most up to date information for success on the field.

\*Alberta Soccer reserves the right to adjust on a case-by-case basis.

### 2 YEARS OR LESS OF INACTIVITY (April 1 to March 31)

- Complete the yearly registration process which includes:
  - Waiver and personal information update
  - Yearly payment
  - o Completion of outdoor or indoor questionnaire (as applicable)
  - o Participation in outdoor or indoor refresher course (as applicable)

## 3 TO 5 YEARS OF INACTIVITY (April 1 to March 31)

- Complete the Canada Soccer Entry Level Referee Course virtual modules only.

- Provide completion certificate of CSA Entry Level modules to Referee Development Lead for approval.
- Complete ASA Registration and yearly payment through current Refcentre account.
- Complete outdoor/indoor questionnaire with passing mark through Refcentre (as applicable).
- Register for and attend an outdoor/indoor refresher course as applicable (as applicable).



# 6 OR MORE YEARS OF INACTIVITY (April 1 to March 31)

- Complete the Canada Soccer Entry Level Referee Course in its entirety (modules and inclass).
  - o Available courses throughout the year can be found at www.refcentre.com/alberta.
- A new account will be created in Refcentre through registration of the entry level course.
- Prior Refcentre accounts will remain available for historical information but will not be used for present and future registrations.
