

## MINOR LACROSSE RELEASE REQUEST

Prior to submitting any release request, the player must be registered with their resident MMLL Association for the current year.

The MMLL "Release Request Form" must be used in all cases where a player wishes to be released from their current lacrosse Association in order to play for another Association. The player, the parent or the guardian must complete all fields in Section 1 and send it to the President of the Association from which the release is requested. Only the information presented in Section 1 will be considered; new reasons for a release will not be entertained should the Association's decision be appealed at any other level.

The Association must respond to the applicant within 72 hours to acknowledge receipt of the request for a release. Once the Association has made a decision, Section 2 of this form must be completed with written reasons for granting or denying the request.

A written appeal must be submitted within five business days to the MMLL. A non-refundable appeal fee of \$50 must be enclosed along with all documentation per Regulation 8 of the MMLL Regulations
