



Parent Code of Conduct

The Mississauga Majors are committed to provide a safe and fun environment for participants to play organized baseball.

As a Parent and member of the Mississauga Majors Baseball Association, you understand and agree to the following:

- Let all participants play for the fun of the game and do not spoil your participant or any other participant's fun.
- Encourage your participant to play by the rules and to enjoy the game.
- Respect all players, coaches, opponents, game officials and spectators.
- The Mississauga Majors does not tolerate situations of harassment or abuse directed against game officials, players, coaches or spectators be it verbal, email, texting or social media.
- Recognize that every member of Mississauga Majors Baseball Association is a volunteer dedicating their time and effort for all members and participants.
- Providing help and encouragement to volunteers whenever possible will assist them to work to the best of their ability and benefit everyone.

- Recognize and applaud good play by your participant as well as members of both teams.
- Do not embarrass your participant by yelling at players, coaches, game officials or spectators.
- Your participant will benefit when you show a positive attitude towards the game and all of its participants.

Failure to comply with this code of conduct will result in disciplinary action.

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in baseball are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six (6) core principles:

Trustworthiness
Respect
Responsibility
Fairness
Caring
Good citizenship

The highest potential of the game of baseball is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character” and in an effort to achieve this potential, The Mississauga Majors Baseball Association has developed and will enforce Codes of Conduct for every level of membership in the association.
